Since they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the equipment and are much less susceptible to damage. As opposed to the quick-tach bucket models, universal fit buckets are 50 percent. This extra room makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for instance backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.
